

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Bio Collectors Group (BCG) is a specialist company that operates facilities for the treatment of organic wastes.

BCG recognizes that its activities have the potential to impact on the environment by impacting on the local amenity, releasing emissions to air and water, and generation of waste. BCG seeks to minimise its impact locally and on the wider environment through the deployment of environmental controls and monitoring, and the management and operation of the facility through this EMS.

This policy applies to the operation and management of the accelerated in-vessel biological treatment facility.

BCG's Director has overall responsibility for the Environmental Management System.

The Environment Manager is responsible for ensuring this policy is implemented.

Relevant site personnel are responsible for ensuring the aims and objectives of the policy are met.

Bio Collectors Group will:

- comply with all environmental regulatory requirements relevant to the industry sector in which it operates;
- meet its waste duty of care requirements by ensuring the safe keeping, transportation and subsequent recovery or disposal of wastes;
- ensure the plant is properly maintained and operated to minimise risk to the environment and surrounding amenity of the area;
- increase employee environmental awareness and ensure all staff are aware of the environmental policy;
- ensure relevant staff are trained in the maintenance/operating requirements of the plant and dealing with accidents and emergency situations that could have an environmental impact;
- operate the Environment Management System, audit its implementation and effectiveness and take corrective action to resolve non-conformances to demonstrate a commitment to continuous improvement of environmental performance;
- BCG will make this policy available when requested to interested parties including members of the public.
